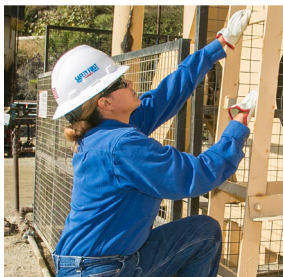
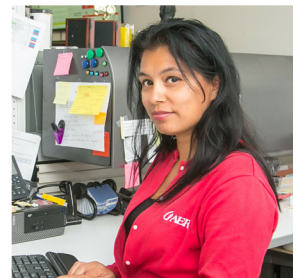
WHAT WE DO
